

### Investment

Fees are paid per subject, per term in advance. FEE-HELP is available for eligible Australian citizens and some permanent residents.

### \*For IELTS, you will need a minimum score of 7.0 overall, with no individual score less than 6.5.

For TOEFL iBT, you will need a minimum score of 102, with a written score minimum of 24 and no individual score lower than 21.

PTE Overall score minimum of 65, with writing skills of minimum 65 and no other communicative skill below 50

### To apply, you should have:

- Two years' full-time work experience
- An undergraduate degree in any discipline or six years' work experience
- An excellent command of English (evidence may be required)

Apply online via our website at **apply.mbs.edu**. You will be asked to provide the following information:

- Responses to four questions that should be between 250 and 300 words in length. (Not required for Prof. Cert. or Grad. Cert.)
- The names and contact details of two professional referees. An email will be sent to these referees requesting feedback on your suitability for the program. (Important: MBA and Grad. Dip. applicantions only - not required for Prof. Cert. or Grad. Cert.)
- Electronic copies of:
  - Academic transcript(s) of all tertiary education, showing all subjects undertaken and results achieved.
  - CV.
  - Proof of citizenship (birth certificate, citizenship certificate or passport with visa).
- Please attach any relevant supporting documents that you believe will enhance your application.

Upon admission, certified copies of these documents will be required.

Meeting these requirements does not guarantee selection.

It is a university requirement that applicants provide evidence that they meet the published entry requirements. Uncertified documentation does not provide this evidence; however we accept uncertified documents for the purpose of selection, and reserve the right to request your original certified documentation at any time.
